Thank you for joining us in prayer!

DAY ONE:

We're thankful for the work and success of the ministry thus far, but let's *pray and fast* with urgency for a fresh anointing and for DMM to keep moving forward in the Middle East. Pray for the leading of the Holy Spirit to direct the ministry's endeavors and the strategic planting of underground house churches.

ACTS 20:22-24

"And now, compelled by the Spirit, I am going to Jerusalem, not knowing what will happen to me there. I only know that in every city the Holy Spirit warns me that prison and hardships are facing me. However, I consider my life worth nothing to me; my only aim is to finish the race and complete the task the Lord Jesus has given me—the task of testifying to the good news of God's grace."

DAY TWO:

Intercede for Muslims all over the world, that they would accept Jesus Christ as the one true God and that the Holy Spirit would reveal the perfect love of God through His Son. Pray with faith that God can reveal Himself through dreams and visions or any divine move of the Spirit.

1 CORINTHIANS 2:9-10A

"However, as it is written: 'What no eye has seen, what no ear has heard, and what no mind has conceived'—the things God has prepared for those who love him—these are the things God has revealed to us by his Spirit."

DAY THREE:

Pray that Muslims involved in terrorism would know that it is evil and not effective; that they would see the devastation of violence. Pray that their plans are foiled and the terrorists are caught before a plan is carried out.

ISAIAH 60:17B-18

"I will make peace your governor and well-being your ruler. No longer will violence be heard in your land, nor ruin or destruction within your borders, but you will call your walls Salvation and your gates Praise."

DAY FOUR:

Pray for the protection of Muslim believers and leaders who are evangelizing their Muslim friends and holding worship services in dangerous areas. They need great wisdom, courage and confidence as they infiltrate the enemy's territory.

PSALM 27:1-3

"The Lord is my light and my salvation—whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life—of whom shall I be afraid? When the wicked advance against me to devour me, it is my enemies and my foes who will stumble and fall. Though an army besiege me, my heart will not fear; though war break out against me, even then will I be confident."

DAY FIVE:

Pray for a generous provision of the resources necessary for the ministry to be effective and productive in the work that the Lord has assigned us to do in the Middle East. We need people with the gift of "giving" to help support the work and the laborers out in the field.

2 CORINTHIANS 9:8, 12

"And God can bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work. This service that you perform is not only supplying the needs of the Lord's people but is also overflowing in many expressions of thanks to God."

DAY SIX:

Regardless of the cultural climate in the Middle East, we know that those who have put their faith and trust in Jesus Christ can experience an inner peace through prayer that is beyond human understanding. Pray that the evidence of the peace of God in the lives of believers will be a testimony to those who suffer from the oppression of fear and hatred.

PHILIPPIANS 4:6

"Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."

DAY SEVEN:

Pray that as Muslims worship their god Allah, there would be a growing discontentment with their religious practices and a sense of emptiness would cause them to search for the one true God.

ISAIAH 43:8

"Lead out those who have eyes but are blind, who have ears but are deaf."

DAY EIGHT:

God is a mighty deliverer who is able to break the stronghold of culture and traditions in the lives of those who put their faith in Jesus Christ. Pray for those in the Middle East who believe in Christ but still are tied to culture and traditions that do not honor the Lord.

2 CORINTHIANS 10:3-5

"For though we live in the world, we do not wage war as the world does. The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ."

DAY NINE:

As the Gospel of Jesus Christ spreads through the open door in the Middle East, there is a great need for laborers willing to put their hand to the plow and not look back. Pray that there would be men and women who consider the cost to work in the field of souls and are a true representation of the character of Christ.

MATTHEW 9:37-38

“The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.”

DAY TEN:

Current events and the political climate in our nation have been the cause of fear, hatred and prejudice for Muslims worldwide. The Church of Jesus Christ will become powerless if it allows the filter of prejudice to cover its heart for reaching out to Muslims or any other people group worldwide.

1 JOHN 2:4-6

“Whoever says, ‘I know him,’ but does not do what he commands is a liar, and the truth is not in that person. But if anyone obeys his word, love for God is truly made complete in them. This is how we know we are in him: Whoever claims to live in him must live as Jesus did.”

DAY ELEVEN:

We all know that whenever we labor for the Lord, the enemy will more than likely attack our families, relationships, finances and/or health. Pray for the protection and wellbeing of all those within the GCM ministry so that the work may continue and not be hindered.

PSALM 25:20-21

“Guard my life and rescue me; do let me be put to shame, for I take refuge in you. May integrity and uprightness protect me, because my hope, Lord, is in you.”

DAY TWELVE:

Pray that God would equip the underground house churches with shepherds who are willing to lay down their lives for the flock.

1 PETER 5:2-3

“Be shepherds of God’s flock that is under your care, watching over them—not because you must, but because you are willing, as God wants you to be; not pursuing dishonest gain, but eager to serve; not lording it over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock.”

DAY THIRTEEN:

Over the past ten years, Global Catalytic Ministries has helped spark an underground Christian movement in one of the world’s leading terrorist countries. As the ministry moves forward, pray that God would bring affluent people who have influence in the Middle East to help expand our network of supporters both practically and financially.

MATTHEW 7:7-8

“Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened.”

DAY FOURTEEN:

More than 95% of GCM's evangelists/disciple makers are volunteers who risk their lives every day to share God's Word with some 1,800 Muslims. GCM would never have the amount of success it does without this volunteer base. Pray for the protection of all the volunteers and their families.

COLOSSIANS 1:9-12

"For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you. We continually ask God to fill you with the knowledge of his will through all the wisdom and understanding that the Spirit gives, so that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God, being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience, and giving joyful thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of his holy people in the kingdom of light."

DAY FIFTEEN:

CNN has used terms like "war crimes" and "crimes against humanity" when it comes to Syria and the recent chemical warfare against its own people. The merciless war on its own children is an indication of what evil really is! *Pray and fast* to combat this level of evil in the world!

PROVERBS 24:19-20

"Do not fret because of evildoers or be envious of the wicked, for the evildoer has no future hope, and the lamp of the wicked will be snuffed out."

DAY SIXTEEN:

Drug addiction is running rampant, not only in our nation but also in the Middle East. Addiction to drugs and alcohol has become a common way of life for many and has repeated itself from one generation to another. This stronghold can only truly be broken through the power of the Holy Spirit and prayer (and fasting)!

MARK 9:29

"This kind can come out only by prayer and fasting."

DAY SEVENTEEN:

Lord, we are thankful for the many Muslim lives who have put their faith and trust in Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. We ask that You will send the wind of the Holy Spirit to awaken their hearts and minds afresh so that they do not grow faint-hearted through the trials and tribulations that they face daily in the Middle East.

ISAIAH 40:29-31

"He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak. Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall; but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint."

DAY EIGHTEEN:

Terrorism is on the rise in the world and the ISIS attacks on Christians are an ever-increasing threat. The political unrest in the world provides an even greater avenue for ISIS to strategically infiltrate the minds of young men and women who want to believe in a united cause. Pray that the divisive political lines would be broken and that there might be a united front in the attack against terrorism.

EPHESIANS 6:10-12

"Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms."

DAY NINETEEN:

Dear Lord, we pray for a greater measure of love and compassion so that we might be a true representation of Your Son, Jesus Christ. Help us walk out our faith as we disciple new believers so that they can see with their own eyes the evidence of the grace of God.

1 TIMOTHY 4:12

"Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity."

DAY TWENTY:

Throughout history, many wars have been fought based on religious beliefs. Religion has been the cause of much hatred in the world and instead of promoting unity, it has caused division. That should not be for those who believe in the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The Gospel is a message of relationship through the love of God. Pray for a fresh baptism of love so that the work in the Middle East would demonstrate relationship with God and others, not religion.

GALATIANS 5:6B *"The only thing that counts is faith expressing itself through love."*

DAY TWENTY-ONE:

Lord, we pray for those in leadership at Global Catalytic Ministries, that You would strengthen them and give them a clear vision for working with Muslims in the Middle East. Please provide the resources necessary to do a work of excellence, and provide the manpower needed to carry out the vision!

1 CORINTHIANS 15:58
