What you hold in your hands is a love offering to the Lord, an offering formed through the hidden faithfulness of the underground church, the perseverance of disciple-makers across the nations, the quiet labor of GCM's operations, and the generosity of believers like you who have chosen to stand with Jesus in the darkest places of the earth.

Every story in these pages is a testimony lifted up to God: not to celebrate human ability, but to glorify the One who still seeks the lost, still heals the broken, still visits His people with power, and still draws nations to Himself. We bring this offering together, field workers, intercessors, supporters, staff, and disciples from every region, because none of this belongs to us. It belongs to Him. We also share this report in a moment when the world is shaking. Nations rage, division grows, and fear seems to multiply on every side. Yet Jesus prepared us for days like these. As you read, let your heart return to His final words in John 16:

"In this world, you will have trouble. But take heart; I have overcome the world."

This is the anchor beneath every story. The underground church does not advance because circumstances are favorable. It advances because Christ has overcome, and because His people continue to obey Him, even in the shadows, even in danger, even when no one sees.

As you walk through each section of this report, we invite you to use it as a prayer guide. Pause over names, nations, stories, and breakthroughs. Pray for those who are suffering for the name of Jesus. Pray for those who are hearing the Gospel for the first time. Pray for the hundreds of unseen workers who risk everything to carry His message forward. Pray for the nations where GCM has entered and for those we have yet to reach.

May this offering draw you into gratitude, awe, and intercession. May it strengthen your faith and that your resources have produced much fruit. And may the Lord use it to knit our hearts together in His mission, until the day we see the fullness of His promise:

Jesus has overcome the world.

Jesus is building His church.

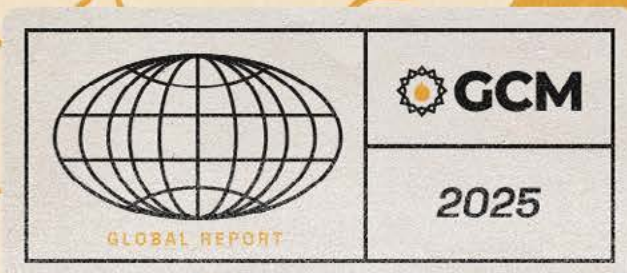
And the darkness has not overcome it.

Global Catalytic Ministries serves as a connective hub for active, coached disciple-makers, both paid and unpaid, now operating in over 70 countries. To bring health and contextualization, we organize the world into eight regions and currently have active teams in six: the Middle East, Far East, Africa, Europe, South America, and North America. This regional structure helps us stay relational and accountable while still empowering decentralized, Spirit-led disciple-making at the edges, where movements actually grow.

This report reflects only what our paid disciple-makers safely reported, not the thousands of unpaid disciples serving worldwide, and because our work is decentralized and often sensitive, we don't require comprehensive reporting or use statistics to evaluate people, so these totals are conservative and the real impact is much higher.



Middle East



ISRAEL TEAM

In 2025, our work in Israel advanced quietly but meaningfully beneath the noise of war and global division. Jewish seekers are opening the Scriptures, and early-stage disciple-making communities are forming in sensitive locations, including growing engagement connected to ultra-Orthodox contexts where trust takes time and relationships move slowly. What is especially significant is that “to the Jew first” is becoming more than theology. We are seeing increasing access points where Jewish disciples are reaching their own people, and former Muslims are discipling Israelis as part of a slow, patient harvest. We’ve also watched hearts soften in ways only the Holy Spirit can do, including one ex-Muslim disciple saying, “I no longer feel hatred toward Jewish people.”

This year included steady, relational rhythms that are hard to measure but deeply formative: weekly meals with Orthodox and former-Orthodox Jews where ongoing disciple-making is happening; hospital access in Haifa where both staff and residents are being impacted through prayer, Scripture, and Jesus stories; and a powerful divine interruption when a suicidal person encountered one of our team members unexpectedly and responded immediately to Yeshua in repentance and tears, followed by two back-to-back Discovery Bible Studies and a desire to continue weekly and bring others. We’ve also seen sustained fruit in Hebron, where the work has pushed into multiple generations of disciple-making, new DBS groups, healings, and new baptisms reported from the field. Alongside local outreach (including multiple outreaches in Nazareth and ongoing engagement with two families), the team has also had outreach moments to Israelis in Thailand, recognizing that Jews are going out from Israel to the nations, and God is meeting them there through gospel conversations, prayer, and healings that lead into ongoing DBS that can continue online as people travel.

At the same time, two very sensitive access points have continued where Jews and Arabs together are engaging Muslims through Jesus storytelling and discovery in and around Bethlehem. Because of security realities, this cannot happen weekly, but consistent access every few weeks is allowing the Lord to build something durable. Finally, we continued strengthening the broader ecosystem around Israel: people inside Israel are being trained online and coached into DMM, seekers are being disciplined online as they grow into faith (with several reported conversions and some preparing for baptism), Jewish communities in Europe have been engaged inside synagogue contexts through Jesus stories, and long-term relational bridges are forming with ultra-Orthodox Jewish communities in Eastern Europe. We also continued training and coaching support connected to Israel’s wider networks, including resourcing a large Korean team serving Israel and providing trauma care support for connected teams under sustained strain.

IRAQ TEAM



In Iraq, 2025 became a year of quiet but undeniable Kingdom advance as the gospel continued to move through places marked by war, trauma, and deep spiritual resistance. Across the region, 23 baptisms took place, each one representing profound courage in a context where following Jesus can cost everything. Our teams continued long-term ministry among former ISIS widows and camp communities, and one of our disciple-makers served inside an ISIS refugee camp, quietly discipling seekers who approach secretly and gathering small groups that meet in hidden spaces to learn the words of Jesus. Another breakthrough came when a disciple-maker transporting Bibles and study guides was stopped at a police checkpoint. As officers examined the materials, the Holy Spirit gave him peace, and he offered the officer one of the books. Days later, the officer contacted him privately, asking to learn more, and he is now being disciplined. Even in environments shaped by fear and control, the gospel continues to move through unexpected relationships and Spirit-led openings.

Beyond these on-the-ground stories, regional training expanded significantly and momentum spread outward from Iraq, influencing regional networks and cross-border teams. Eleven leaders in Cyprus and twelve Arab disciple-makers from five nations entered ongoing coaching, strengthening a growing web of active disciple-making pathways across the Middle East. Our coached UAE team led a face-to-face training for new workers and is now coaching them toward multiplication. A group of expat work-

ers serving across five nations received refresher DMM training and renewed accountability as they continue reaching local populations. Throughout the year, we maintained continuous coaching and prayer with a persecuted minority group inside Iraq, and local Muslim Background Believer leaders continued discipling under severe pressure, strengthened through steady pastoral support, coaching rhythms, and prayer covering. The landscape remains dangerous, yet the courage of Iraqi believers and the growing regional network around them testify that Jesus is building His church in some of the hardest soil on earth, and nothing can stop the advance of His Kingdom.

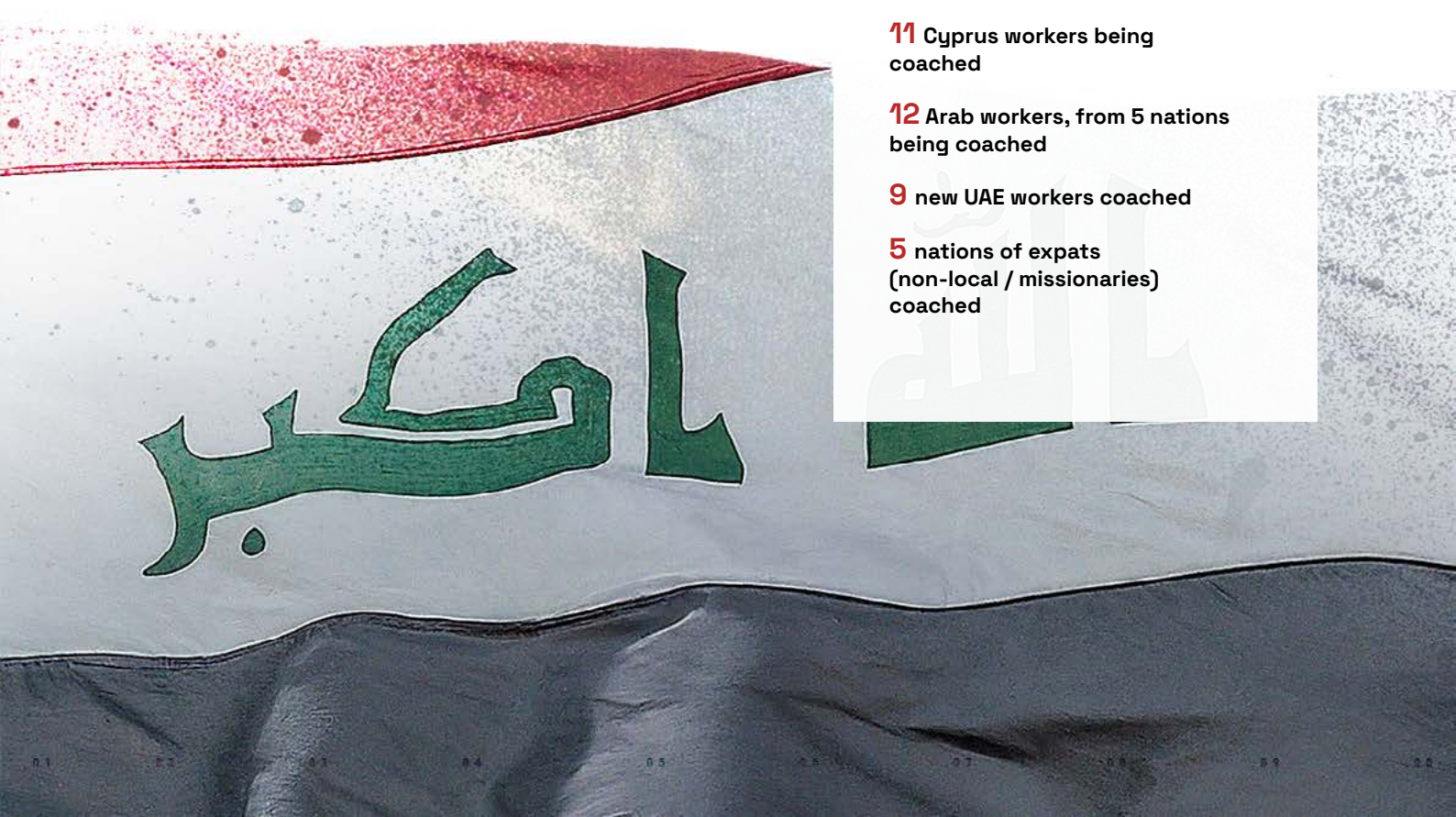

EGYPT TEAM

+ FIELD STATION

In 2025, Egypt emerged as one of the most fruitful and stabilizing centers of ministry in the MENA region, serving as both a training ground and a refuge for the persecuted. More than 80 Egyptian disciple-makers were trained and strengthened, along with leaders from Saudi Arabia, Nigeria, Brazil, and the United States, resulting in the launch of first-generation Discovery Groups. Six Western workers were also deployed into the region, while Egyptian Muslim Background Believer leaders gained renewed courage and clarity through ongoing coaching. Egypt quietly became a long-term deployment hub as GCM helped launch a fully operational underground field station, a strategic, locally owned hub designed to sustain movement growth in persecuted environments.

This field station played a critical role in forming teams prepared to infiltrate Gaza and Syria, strengthening unity in the region through two strategic partnerships with major missions organizations, and providing free coaching to their workers. It also served as a safe house for two disciple-makers expelled from Saudi Arabia and became a lifeline for a Libyan believer who escaped a critical situation. In addition, expat leaders working across five nations received refresher training and ongoing coaching, strengthening their ability to reach local populations. Egypt has become not only a center of stability, but a launching point for courageous disciple-makers carrying the gospel into some of the most spiritually contested places on earth.

LIBYA TEAM



In Libya, Jesus is building His church in hidden places through costly obedience and steady, patient disciple-making. What began as a simple online gathering with two people is already growing as new locals join, a quiet reminder that God often starts movements small and faithful. On the ground, a neighbor who has been prayed for over time openly declared himself a follower of Jesus and asked for prayer to receive the Holy Spirit, and he is now stepping into the work of reaching other neighbors who are still in the other religion.

This fruit is coming in the shadow of real persecution. After being arrested and tortured in 2023 alongside other disciples, one of our coaches was released, taken offline for healing, and by God's grace returned this year with his wife to continue the work in one of the most hostile environments toward the gospel. Underground baptisms are continuing, simple churches are forming, and new leaders are emerging. One of the clearest examples is a sister who was recently baptized, her family discovered it, locked her in her room, and tortured her for weeks. Then, without explanation, they released her and acted as if nothing happened. She is now leading Discovery groups and praying for wisdom to lead her own family to Jesus.

IRAN TEAM



In Iran, Jesus is strengthening His underground church through quiet courage, simple obedience, and rapid multiplication. As coaching and training increased this year, believers grew in boldness, clarity of identity in Christ, and perseverance, and Discovery Groups began multiplying as new groups formed across multiple provinces. Two secret in-country trainings became a major catalyst, equipping believers with a focus on Identity in Christ and Marriage, and creating space for both first-time faith decisions and renewed surrender to Jesus. Alongside this, a trusted baptism pathway through Istanbul continued serving Iranian believers traveling through, and momentum is building toward 2026 with plans to join the team and baptize many more in an undisclosed location in the Middle East. To strengthen worship and endurance for believers who often worship in secrecy, original Farsi worship songs were developed to be sent into Iran via satellite to edify and encourage the underground church.

SYRIA TEAM



In 2025, God began forming something new inside Syria. A new Syrian team emerged and new disciples began shepherding early Discovery groups, even as conflict and instability continued around them. New believers were baptized, including first fruit among Druze communities, and Lebanese MBB leaders were launched into Syria to help strengthen what is taking root. One of the clearest pictures of the kind of faith being multiplied is Sister H, who sensed the Lord calling her away from personal safety and toward her own Shiite community, even knowing the cost. On the journey in, she attempted to pass through an ISIS-controlled corridor, was arrested and interrogated by security forces, and yet was unexpectedly released and allowed to pass. She is now embedded in a Shiite community, committed to discipling where it is most dangerous, a living reminder that this work is not theory, it is obedience happening in real time. Sister S's steady faithfulness also led to the first baptisms among Druze communities inside Syria, showing the gospel reaching into places many assume are unreachable. As we look to 2026, we are preparing to send three waves of disciples to deepen and expand these Jesus-centered strongholds in one of the most persecuted places on earth.

MECCA TEAM

In 2025, the Lord did something we do not take lightly, He strengthened an underground work in the heart of Saudi Arabia that only Jesus could sustain. A women's underground conference quietly gathered more than 200 women under cover, one of the first known underground Christian women's gatherings in the country. Out of that hidden fellowship and discipleship, a breakthrough emerged that still feels impossible to say out loud, the first underground church planted in Mecca in its 1,400-year history. This is not a public movement and it is not built on platforms, it is women, families, and new believers being discipled in ordinary homes with extraordinary courage. A women-led house church has formed and disciple-making groups continue to grow underground as Muslim Background Believer leaders are coached, supported, and strengthened across the region.

FIVE-NATION ARAB TEAM

(CYPRUS, LEBANON, IRAQ, YEMEN, SAUDI)

In 2025, the Lord moved powerfully across the five-nation Arab region as new believers were formed, strengthened, and sent into some of the most spiritually and politically volatile places in the Middle East. New disciples were trained and immediately began launching in-person Discovery Groups, early seeds of gospel presence in unreached communities. Cyprus also emerged as a growing hub of regional influence and cross-border ministry as additional disciples were trained and brought into coaching. In Lebanon, Muslim Background Believers continued making disciples even as wartime bombardment shook their neighborhoods, and Lebanese believers were launched into Syria where new groups are forming among families deeply affected by conflict. This network is also pioneering new social media approaches designed to reach People of Peace across the Middle East, creating fresh pathways for discovery, discipleship, and underground communities of faith. At the same time, the UAE team has taken meaningful steps toward multiplication, training new workers face to face and moving into independent coaching, a sign that second-generation trainers are emerging. Across the region, cross-border discipleship networks are strengthening, groups are forming where traditional missions cannot operate, and faith is growing under persecution, conflict, and instability.

PRAY for the REGION

- Pray for open doors, People of Peace, and spiritually hungry seekers across the Middle East.
- Ask the Lord to increase spiritual openness, especially in places long marked by violence and trauma like Iraq, Mosul, and surrounding regions. Pray that seekers courageously enter the journey of discovering God through His Word, that new relational networks open through unexpected contacts, and that the gospel advances through families, youth, university students, and unreached neighborhoods. Pray for protection, courage, stability, and wellbeing for disciple-makers and their families.
- Pray for Muslim Background Believers and frontline leaders discipling under surveillance, cultural pressure, and wartime instability. Ask for supernatural covering, endurance, wisdom, and safety for households and children, including emotional peace, belonging, and resilience. Pray for high-risk meetings and assignments, that the Lord would guide every step with discernment and protection.
- Pray for Discovery Groups and spiritual families to form, multiply, and mature into lasting movements.
- Ask the Lord to establish new Discovery Groups and multiply first-generation groups into second and third generations with speed and stability. Pray for believers to share boldly as God moves in their lives, especially where gatherings are risky or restricted. Intercede for the formation of real spiritual family, healthy communities of obedience, and multiplication through local relational networks.
- Pray for healing, restoration, and breakthrough among the wounded, displaced, and spiritually oppressed.
- Lift up former ISIS widows, camp communities, refugees, and war-impacted families across Iraq and Syria. Pray for trauma healing, hope, forgiveness, and new beginnings. Pray for underground workers serving inside ISIS-affected camps, that God would give discernment and open hearts in hidden settings. Intercede for persecuted minority communities to be strengthened, encouraged, and multiplied as they disciple their own families and neighbors.
- Pray for regional unity, cross-border multiplication, and trusted partnerships that strengthen the work.
- Pray for deep unity, humility, and shared obedience among disciple-makers from diverse backgrounds across MENA, that competition and division would have no foothold. Bless the training and coaching streams reaching leaders in Egypt, Iraq, Cyprus, the UAE, and across multiple Arab nations, and ask God to turn seeds into movements. Pray for expat workers reaching locals across several nations with wisdom and cultural sensitivity, for strategic partnerships to deepen in healthy unity, and for protected, fruitful regional hubs that enable expansion into high-risk areas like Gaza and Syria.



Far East



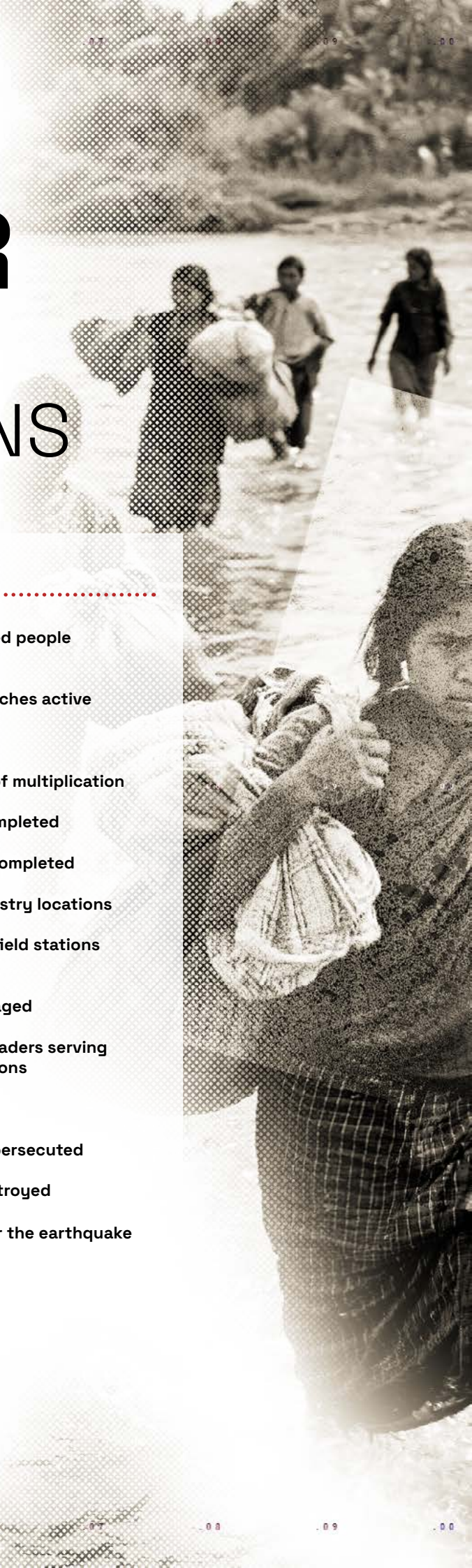
MYANMAR TEAM + FIELD STATIONS

In Myanmar, 2025 was a year of both extraordinary suffering and extraordinary gospel advance as the underground church demonstrated courage, unity, and supernatural resilience. Despite civil war, military airstrikes, displacement, and a devastating earthquake, the team pressed forward with remarkable faith. Two fully unreached people groups were reached for the first time: the Silver Pilog, where the gospel has already multiplied into four generations of disciples and many have been delivered from alcoholism, and the Intha Lake communities, where two core disciple-makers emerged and are now discipling thirty people through earthquake relief and water-filter ministry.

Three underground field stations were established to quietly move, store, and hide food, water filters, and emergency shelter supplies while bombs from the military government fell nearby, sustaining entire villages through crisis. Trauma coaching strengthened leaders learning how to walk with joy in the midst of PTSD, grief, and martyrdom, and the Palong Bible comic translation, volumes 1 through 9, was completed to help oral cultures receive Scripture in a form they can share. Under intense persecution, the Myanmar team continues to stand as one of the clearest pictures of New Testament faithfulness in our generation, proving again that the light shines brightest where darkness fights hardest.

PAKISTAN TEAM

In Pakistan, 2025 became a year marked by unexpected access, indigenous leadership, and the steady rise of disciple-making across some of the hardest places in the region. God opened doors among multiple unreached people groups, including the Bagri, Mengwal, Marwari, Saansey, Musalman, Kachhi, Daat Ki, and Odh tribes, as local disciple-makers carried the gospel into villages and households in interior Sindh, South Punjab, and beyond.

New believers came to faith, home churches were planted, and entire families began walking with Jesus. Disaster also became a surprising gateway for the gospel. Catastrophic floods allowed teams to enter Buner, one of the most extremist and difficult areas near the Afghan border, where long-term access was previously impossible. Through presence, prayer, and compassion, persons of peace emerged, forming the foundation for ongoing disciple-making relationships. Even in one of Pakistan's most restricted regions, Hunza, God opened a door through a simple tourist-guide role, leading to the first seeds of disciple-making in a place long considered unreachable.

God also opened significant doors among the next generation. Nearly 5,000 children heard the gospel through summer outreaches, and 63 young leaders from all four provinces gathered for focused disciple-making training, strengthening a growing pipeline of indigenous leadership. In brick kiln communities, places often marked by modern-day slavery, Evergreen School launched as a tangible expression of dignity and long-term hope, with 32 children now receiving education and care. The Lord also continued raising multiplying leaders from within the harvest. One of the earliest disciples from a Hindu background has become a reproducing leader, serving communities through education initiatives while multiplying disciples. Among the Baloch, online ministry is translating into on-the-ground discipleship, with new groups forming as seekers move from digital contact to face-to-face relationships.

Alongside these movement stories, we also saw significant expansion of training, baptisms, and public gospel proclamation, especially in Sindh. Over the course of the year, seminars strengthened relationships with leaders and renewed passion for disciple-making, disciples were trained from multiple cities, cell churches were planted in unreached areas, and the gospel was proclaimed widely through open crusade-style outreach, producing new contacts for follow-up and discipleship. Practical mercy also continued, including aid for Afghan believer families and visitation care for prisoners. At the leadership level, doors opened to build relationships with political leaders, aiming for favor and protection for persecuted believers and a clearer gos-

pel voice in public life. Across tribal lines, Afghan, Hindu, Pashtun, Baloch, Saraiki, Muslim-background seekers, and nominal Christians, the Lord is breaking cycles of hate and building bridges of love, while also strengthening believers against destructive cult influences that have pulled some back toward former religions. Through crises, barriers, and decades-long strongholds, God is building an indigenous, sustainable movement carried forward by local believers who speak the heart languages of their people and serve quietly, courageously, and sacrificially.

PHILIPPINES

In the Philippines, 2025 carried both real pain and real momentum as the Lord strengthened local disciple-makers through perseverance and fruit that endured. On-the-ground disciple-making training gathered pastors and leaders from multiple backgrounds and launched several Discovery Bible Studies, including one that multiplied into a student group.

Across this work, disciple-makers and coaches worked among more than 3,000 students in the area, and from that environment a young new believer emerged as a gifted seed-sower and natural multiplier. Four months later, he was tragically killed in a hit-and-run accident, a devastating loss that shook the group deeply. Yet even in grief, Jesus steadied them, the students have recommitted themselves to the mission and are preparing to lead their first disciple-making training in 2026 under the guidance of a former Muslim. Alongside this, GCM has begun partnering with a nearby team of seasoned local disciple-makers who are actively reaching students on school campuses, strengthened through consistent monthly coaching and accountability, a clear sign that the seeds planted are taking root and continuing to multiply.

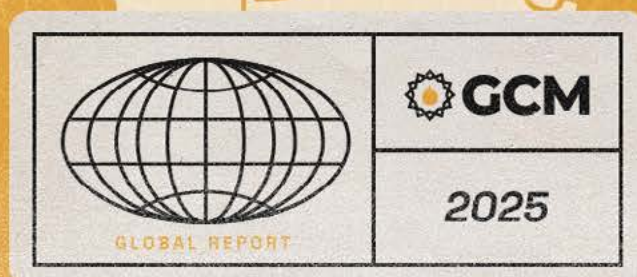
PRAY for the REGION

- Pray for open doors and lasting access in hard and restricted places.
- Ask the Lord to keep doors open in regions like Buner and Hunza, and across interior Sindh and South Punjab. Pray that Persons of Peace continue to emerge, that homes stay open for ongoing visits, and that new contacts from large public outreaches become real discipleship pathways and multiplying Discovery groups.
- Pray for indigenous disciple-makers to be strengthened, protected, and provided for.
- Pray for the local leaders carrying this work, that God would give courage, wisdom, health, and provision as they serve with personal sacrifice. Ask for endurance and protection for those working in high-risk settings, and for growing unity and maturity among disciples from many backgrounds and tribes. Pray for multiplying churches and deep discipleship, not shallow decisions.
- Pray that the baptisms, trainings, and new cell churches lead to mature believers who obey Jesus and disciple others. Ask the Lord to establish healthy, reproducible house churches across unreached communities, and to guard new believers from fear, pressure, and spiritual confusion.
- Pray for breakthrough among families, children, and the next generation.
- Pray for the thousands of children reached, the 63 trained young leaders, and the students at Evergreen School, that seeds planted would grow into lifelong faith and future disciple-makers. Ask God to break cycles of debt, bondage, and generational oppression in brick kiln communities, and to bring whole families into spiritual freedom.
- Pray for wider gospel influence with integrity, love, and protection for the persecuted.
- Pray for the Baloch outreach and other digital-to-on-ground ministry, that God would add laborers, provide tools and resources, and open hearts among unreached people who are engaging online. Pray also for favor and protection for persecuted believers, including Afghan believer families and prisoners being visited, and for wisdom in relationships with civic and political leaders so laws and public outcomes move toward justice, protection, and space for faithful gospel witness.





Africa



AFRICA TEAM

In 2025, Jesus advanced His Kingdom across Africa through united prayer, strategic partnership, and quiet, high-impact disciple-making in places many overlook. In East Africa, a coached leader helped strengthen the church for mission by deploying a trained mentee into a church network to oversee Muslim evangelism, while also building collaboration across ministries so the Great Commission is pursued together rather than in silos. At the same time, the Lord repeatedly confirmed a prophetic theme many believers echoed, “Fire from Cape to Cairo,” and that word became a catalyst for discernment on the ground. During a visit to Cairo, a Sudanese refugee who had left Islam and drifted into agnosticism opened up through simple, Spirit-led conversations, and after prayer for a breakthrough he could not manufacture, his passport was approved and he chose to follow Jesus, now growing while living with real risk as he resides in Saudi Arabia with a Muslim family still behind him. In Zambia, the gospel met a young man carrying the weight of smuggling, arrest, and prison, and through consistent discipleship he was baptized and is now gathering others in Discovery Bible Study, even as the region faces rising Islamic influence through new mosques and strategic expansion. God also opened a relational bridge into Francophone Africa through a divine appointment with a leader from Ivory Coast, connecting us to networks across nations like Benin and Chad and moving them toward practical disciple-making training through the Disciple Making Bootcamp in early 2026. In South Africa, the Lord continued pressing into gang-dominated communities where trust takes time and violence can erupt suddenly, as steady presence and simple, serious, spiritual conversations seek People of Peace among men the world labels unreachable. Across the continent, the story is consistent, Jesus is raising disciple-makers, unifying His people, opening doors through providence, and pushing light into places where darkness assumed it had the final word, including steady outreach among Sudanese and Somali communities through Scripture storying and group-based engagement.

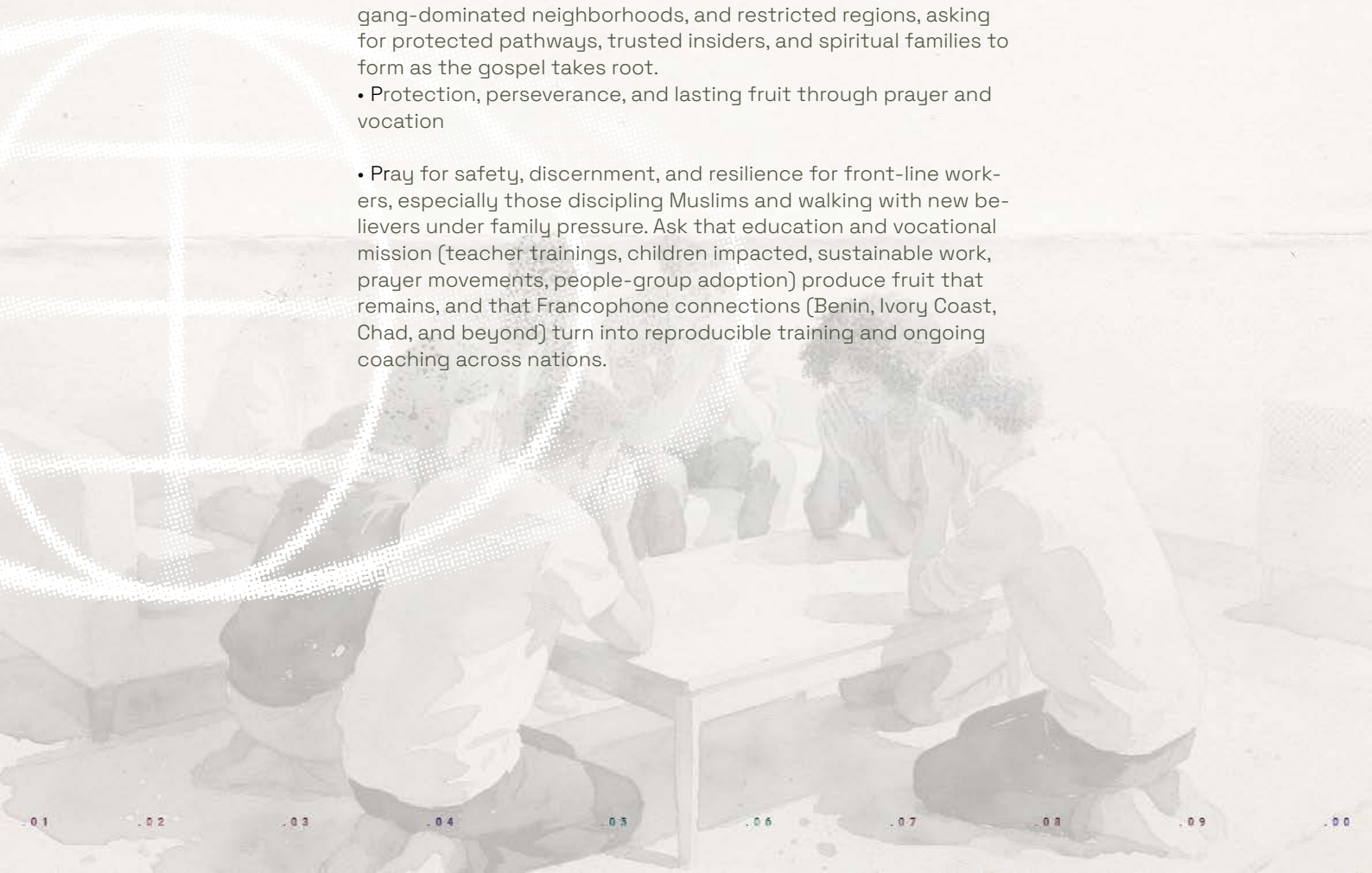

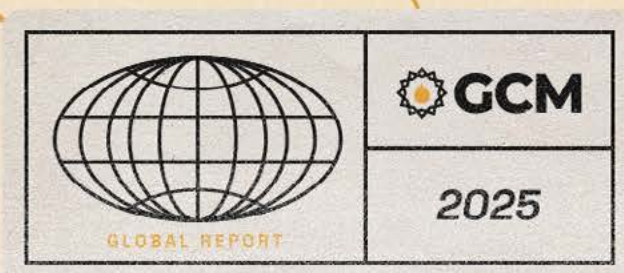
PRAY FOR THE REGION

- Unity and collaboration for the Great Commission
- Pray that African believers and leaders walk in humility, trust, and shared obedience, with partnerships that strengthen the Church's witness instead of competing for influence. Spiritual clarity and courage to engage the moment
- Ask the Lord to open eyes to the spiritual realities shaping the continent, including growing Islamic influence in key areas, and give the Church wisdom, love, boldness, and a clear gospel voice. Disciple-makers rising from every context, including the margins
- Pray for a multiplying wave of local disciple-makers, especially among the young, refugees, and those coming out of gangs, prison, and brokenness, that transformed lives become stable, reproducing leaders.
- Open doors and People of Peace in unreached and resistant places
- Intercede for coastal islands with no known believers, gang-dominated neighborhoods, and restricted regions, asking for protected pathways, trusted insiders, and spiritual families to form as the gospel takes root.
- Protection, perseverance, and lasting fruit through prayer and vocation
- Pray for safety, discernment, and resilience for front-line workers, especially those discipling Muslims and walking with new believers under family pressure. Ask that education and vocational mission (teacher trainings, children impacted, sustainable work, prayer movements, people-group adoption) produce fruit that remains, and that Francophone connections (Benin, Ivory Coast, Chad, and beyond) turn into reproducible training and ongoing coaching across nations.





Europe



Across Europe in 2025, the Lord grew a widening base of disciple-makers and began laying foundations that can multiply with health. The team has grown to more than 100 disciple-makers, with strong concentration in the UK, Norway, and the Netherlands, and growing momentum in France, Germany, Bulgaria, and Italy. At the same time, the Lord has put a clear burden on the region for 5,000 disciple-makers to rise across all 45 European nations, especially as we recognize our presence remains weak or minimal in 35 nations and needs focused breakthrough in 2026. On the ground, Churches are now established in the UK, Norway, and France, and new teams are preparing to launch in 2026 across multiple languages. A prayer movement is also forming, with daily, weekly, and monthly rhythms already totaling about 28 hours of corporate prayer in a typical month, and a Signal-based prayer network being developed to unify intercession across borders. Fruit is showing up in tangible ways through baptisms, People of Peace connections, and discovery groups forming across cultural lines. One of the clearest signs of Europe maturing into a sending region is that a worker is now preparing to be sent to Somalia to reach Yemeni refugees, a picture of cross-border courage and gospel access that we are asking the Lord to multiply. In Italy, this same quiet roots before visible fruit pattern is especially clear in a spiritually resistant context where trust has been slow to build, yet consistent presence, hospitality, and mercy are opening doors. Discovery rhythms are forming, unity with local churches is strengthening, and a growing prayer catalyst among young people is spreading through camps and trainings, creating real runway for lasting disciple-making.

PRAY for the REGION

- Pray for a continent-wide disciple-making breakthrough.
- Ask the Lord to raise up 5,000 disciple-makers across all 45 European nations, strengthening and multiplying the new churches in the UK, Norway, and France, and establishing healthy new teams launching in multiple languages in 2026, including Italy.
- Pray for courageous, humble local leaders and new movements.
- Intercede for emerging leaders to walk in clarity, obedience, and spiritual authority. Pray specifically for momentum and rooted, reproducing disciple-makers in Italy, Spain, Portugal, Hungary, and Bulgaria.
- Pray for People of Peace and opened networks.
- Ask Jesus to lead workers to People of Peace like the new believer baptized in Norfolk, the French Catholic exploring DBS with his network, and the Sudanese Muslim leading a DBS in Arabic in London. Pray for similar open doors across Europe, especially in communities that have resisted the gospel for generations, including Italy.
- Pray for a unified prayer movement and spiritual resilience.
- Pray for the growing rhythms of corporate prayer, about 28 hours monthly, to expand with unity and power, and for the Signal prayer network to knit disciple-makers together across nations and languages. Also pray for breakthrough among the young, immigrants, refugees, and those in addiction, crime, or prison, and for transformation in hard places and strongholds like Lionstreet, Bryne City, and the Stavanger Cultural Center, and for similar openings across Italy and Europe.
- Pray for sending capacity and global impact beyond Europe.
- Ask the Lord to prepare and protect the disciple-maker being sent to Somalia to reach Yemeni refugees, and to form Europe into both a harvest field and a missionary-sending continent. Lift up nations beyond Europe touched by European partners, including the Philippines, for faithful workers, freedom from trafficking, abuse, corruption, and for youth to encounter Jesus as

Redeemer and King.



South & Central America



In 2025, the Lord began to stir South and Central America in a way that felt less like quick expansion and more like deep formation. Across multiple nations, leaders consistently shared the same theme, Jesus was calling His people to a higher level of surrender. As we pursued multiplication, the Holy Spirit also surfaced places where healing, repentance, and freedom from trauma, abuse, and sin had to be addressed first, so that what multiplies is healthy, not hurried. In Brazil, this became a defining rhythm of the year through a focused disciple-making training and sustained coaching, strengthened by in-person visits that built relationship, prayer, and sacrificial obedience. Regionally, a sovereign moment unfolded at the Selah Conference in Costa Rica, where the full gospel was proclaimed and leaders were confronted, not with hype, but with Scripture, the reality of the Underground Church, and the urgency of obedience-based disciple-making. Out of that gathering, a new Latin American group was formed and has become a living community of prayer, encouragement, formation, and action. One of our Argentina coaches, who oversees a network of 50 house churches, described this as an answer to years of prayer, a visible shift away from church-as-usual toward biblical disciple-making cultures rooted in Jesus and His first disciples. Many leaders are now being discipled by Underground Church disciple-makers within GCM, and the early fruit is already multiplying through their churches and ministries. At the same time, we continue to carry a burden for believers under pressure in places like Cuba and Nicaragua, where the need for resilient, reproducible disciple-making is urgent as we move into 2026.

PRAY for the REGION

- Pray for deep surrender and lasting inner healing. Ask Jesus to continue what He began in 2025, bringing freedom from trauma, abuse, and sin so leaders multiply healthy disciples, not just activity.
- Pray for the 88 pastors and leaders now entering coaching.
- Pray for humility, obedience, and follow-through, that this “conference breakthrough” becomes real disciple-making on the ground across their churches, households, and networks.
- Pray for multiplication across the nations represented.
- Intercede for Costa Rica, Panama, Guatemala, Cuba, Colombia, Mexico, Argentina, Peru, Brazil, Chile, and Puerto Rico, that People of Peace emerge and Discovery groups form and multiply into stable spiritual families.
- Pray for courage and protection in pressured and persecuted contexts.
- Lift up believers in places like Cuba and Nicaragua, ask the Lord for endurance, wisdom, and supernatural covering, and that suffering would produce bold, reproducing faith.
- Pray for 2026 training and new access in Brazil’s “marketplace” spheres.
- Ask God to anoint the next DMM training, raise up Brazilian co-trainers, and open doors in business, marketing, and technology relationships where new networks can be reached with the gospel.





North America



In 2025, God strengthened a growing North America movement that is simple, relational, and built for multiplication. Through four major disciple-making trainings, more than 100 people were equipped, over 200 coaching calls were completed, and 30 plus Discovery Bible Study groups were started, leading to 2,200 spiritual conversations and 10 baptisms. What stands out most is the steady rhythm behind the fruit, weekly Zoom prayer, weekly worship and prayer nights, and ongoing mentoring of pastors who are now seeing in-home disciple-making take root in their communities. This work is being carried by active, coached disciple-makers, paid and unpaid, serving across Kentucky, Missouri, Ohio, California, Colorado, Michigan, Minnesota, South Carolina, Indiana, Arkansas, Chicago, and Canada. Alongside the disciple-making work, the executive team hosted four local donor dinner gatherings, serving more than 120 GCM supporters and sharing private underground stories that strengthened the sense of family and shared mission. This year also laid groundwork for a new strategy launching in 2026, and as God continues to shake this nation, we believe He is preparing a new wave of obedient disciples who will not settle for church-as-usual.

PRAY for the REGION

- Pray for true People of Peace and multiplying Discovery Groups.
- Ask the Lord to lead disciple-makers to lost men and women who will not only respond to the gospel, but will gather friends, family, and community to discover Scripture together. Pray for multi-person Discovery Bible Studies to form, not only one-to-one studies, and for these groups to multiply naturally through relational networks.
- Pray for consistent, resilient disciple-makers who embrace long obedience.
- Intercede for grace to remain faithful in prayer, engaging the lost, and following up with potential People of Peace. Pray that workers would not grow weary or chase quick results, but would labor with endurance, trusting that movements grow through persistent sowing, careful follow-up, and steady obedience over time.
- Pray for hunger for God and a renewed devotion to prayer across North America.
- Ask the Father, in the name of Jesus, to awaken a singular focus on Christ in His Church, a hunger that reaches the lost and produces laid-down disciples. Pray that prayer would no longer be religious activity, but an invitation into God's heart for families, neighborhoods, and cities, and that the cycle of prayerlessness would be broken by a fresh outpouring of devotion and dependence. Ask the Lord to help North America seek first His Kingdom and deny self daily. (Matthew 6:33, Luke 9:23)
- Pray for humility and revelation concerning Israel and God's covenant story.
- Ask God to humble believers in North America and open eyes to the mystery of Israel, His covenant faithfulness, and the mercy extended to the nations through their story. Pray for grace to love, wash feet, forgive, and carry a Christlike witness that provokes Israel to jealousy in the right way, through humility and sacrificial love, not arguments or pride. (Genesis 49:10, Jeremiah 31:31-34, Ezekiel 36:24-30, Romans 9-11)
- Pray for a corporate witness that reflects Jesus, and for the Kingdom to advance through everyday obedience.
- Ask that disciples across North America would live as citizens of God's active Kingdom now, testifying to the certainty of Jesus' return and the restoration of all things. Pray for families, churches, and communities to embody the cross-shaped life of Jesus with clarity, courage, and love, and that our collective obedience would produce real fruit among the lost and strengthen God's purposes among the nations.

Digital Outreach & Social Media

In 2025, GCM stepped into the digital town square not for self-promotion, but for mission. As the conversation around the rise of Islam in America grew louder and more polarized, we sensed the Lord calling us to bring clarity and truth without fear, while holding tightly to Jesus' way: love your enemies, lay your life down, and make disciples. We began using short-form video and direct teaching to surface the real questions many believers are already wrestling with, then to identify People of Peace who want to obey Jesus in reaching Muslims and the lost in their own communities. The result has been a dramatic expansion of reach and engagement, giving GCM a growing platform to disciple, equip, and mobilize at scale. In 2026, we plan to build on this foundation with more structured teaching, more podcasting, and more live CEO Q&A-style conversations to address questions openly and shepherd people toward obedience.

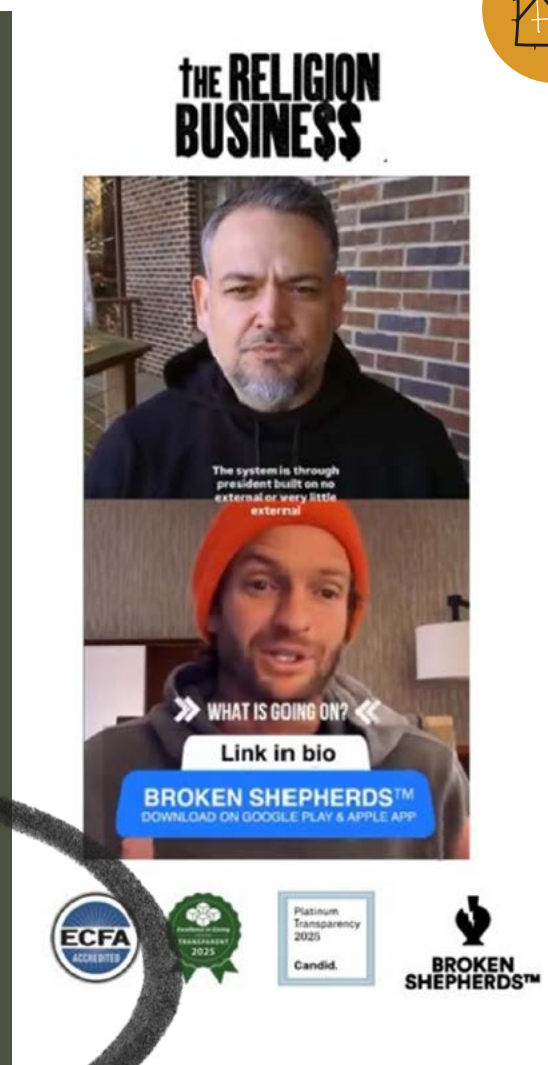
PRAY for the STORYTELLERS

- Pray for purity, protection, and Jesus-centered content.
- Ask the Lord to keep everything we publish anchored in Jesus, free from fear, pride, outrage, or the need to “win” arguments. Pray for protection over our team, our platforms, and the people engaging our content.
- Pray for discernment and courage with hard topics.
- Pray that we would speak truth with compassion, addressing difficult issues without drifting into hostility or compromise, and that our message would consistently point to the gospel, disciple-making, and loving our enemies.
- Pray for People of Peace in the digital town square.
- Ask Jesus to keep drawing spiritually hungry men and women out of the noise and into obedience, people who will not only listen but gather others, open their homes, and begin discovery and discipleship in real community.

FINANCE

At GCM, our posture is simple: nothing is hidden except what must remain hidden to protect our underground leaders. The story this year is clear, GCM is becoming financially healthier, and your giving is directly fueling front-line disciple-making. We are running with a strong program focus, seeing unusually high donor loyalty after the second gift, and building a resilient, movement-shaped funding base that is not dependent on a small handful of major donors. We are also strengthening trust through third-party accountability, including making our 2024 independent audit and 990 publicly available, because we believe transparency is worship and stewardship is a mark of maturity.



In an interview with Religion Business, the GCM CEO affirmed this posture as the organization's core identity. As Religion Business noted, *'GCM has become the de facto tip of the spear in transparency.'*

In **2025**, we set four internal financial goals to keep GCM healthy, lean, and sustainable:

1. Protect program impact by maintaining 75%+ program and 25% or less operations
2. Return to growth and make 2025 our first growth year since the 2021 Afghanistan pullout
3. Build \$200,000 in savings
4. Build \$300,000 in untouched reserves to move toward the 3–6 month operating range, placing GCM among the top 10% of financially healthy organizations globally

By God's grace, we accomplished the first three goals. We did not fully reach the fourth goal yet, but it is a clear target for 2026 as we continue building a healthy, lean central team and strengthening robust, sustainable regional teams, so healthy churches filled with disciple-makers can be planted in every region of the world.

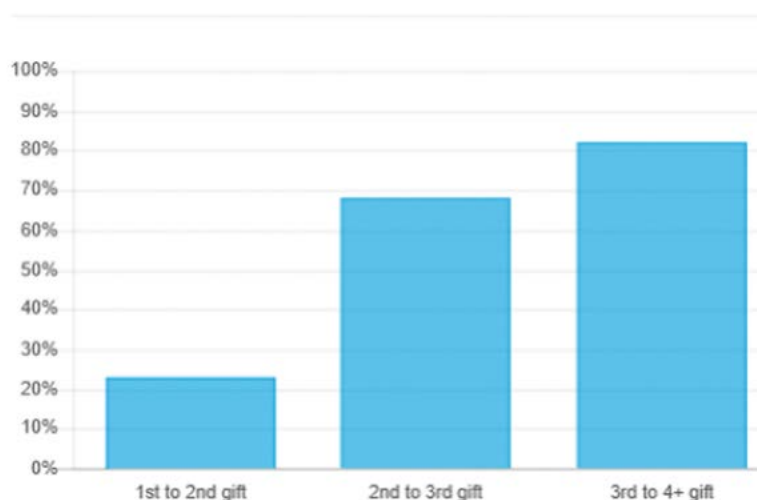

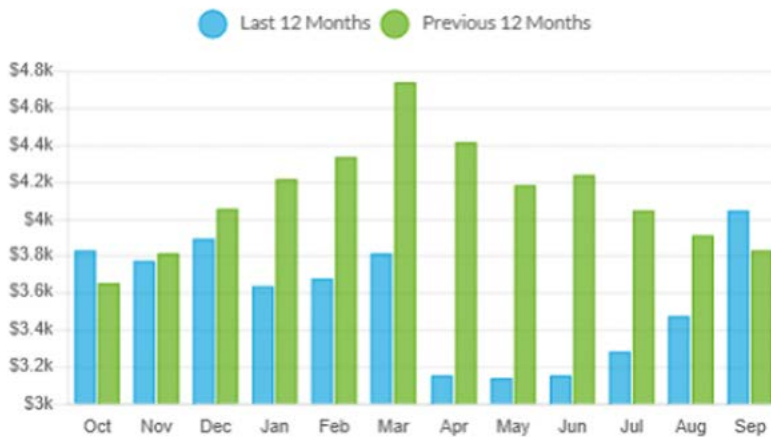

Donor Lifetime Value (



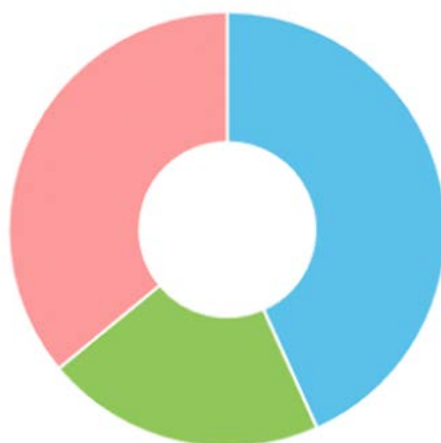

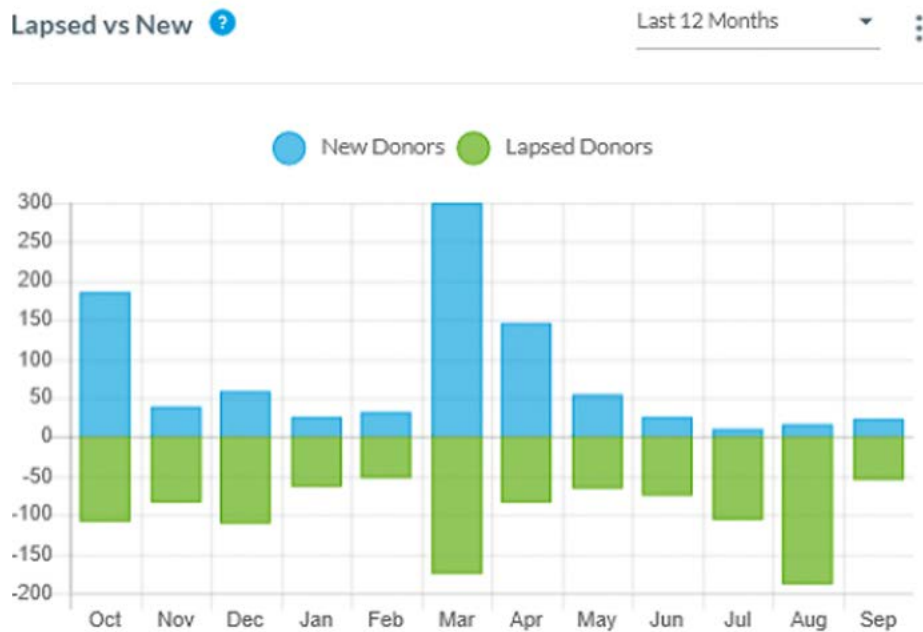

Typical Christian nonprofits receive 60–80% of their funding from the Major Donors tier and only 10% from small donors. This matters because our giving ecosystem is movement-shaped, wide base, not top-heavy. This decentralization makes GCM financially resilient and donor-inclusive.

Donor Acquisition vs. Attrition (Last 12 Months)



- Major new-donor spikes: +180 in October & +300 in March

Most faith-based nonprofits grow only 0–5% annually, but GCM's donor acquisition rose 15–20% this year, significantly outperforming industry expectations.

The Shield Solution: mobilizing strategic donors



SHIELD launched this year as a Kingdom response to some of the most violent, neglected, and spiritually contested regions on earth. Places where traditional missions cannot safely operate, yet where the gospel is advancing with remarkable power. SHIELD exists to serve and strengthen these front-line movements by gathering a small fellowship of Kingdom investors committed to unprecedented transparency, accountability, and direct engagement with the underground church. Their support fuels courageous disciple-makers, many of whom were once persecutors of Christianity but are now leading gospel movements in their own communities. With three current members and a goal of twelve by the end of 2026, we invite you to join us in praying that God will call the right men and women into SHIELD, those who will stand with the underground church where few dare to go. May this group remain rooted in humility, unity, and Spirit-led generosity as together we close the gospel gaps left by traditional funding models and strengthen Christ's work in the hardest places.

In addition, our full 2024 IRS Form 990 and our complete independent financial audit are publicly available for download on our website, reinforcing our belief that accountability is not an obligation but an act of worship before the Lord. As we close this year, the Board of Directors offers our heartfelt thanks for your faithful prayers, generous financial support, and continued partnership. CEO LETTER

Dear friends,

2025 has been one of the most extraordinary years in the history of Global Catalytic Ministries. As you read this report, I want you to see more than outcomes, I want you to see a picture of what happens when Jesus is truly free to lead His people. What you are partnering with is not a centralized ministry trying to build a name or control a system. GCM is intentionally being built as a decentralized family with a centralized message, the gospel of the Kingdom, and decentralized action, disciples obeying Jesus where they live, no matter the cost.

We believe the Kingdom of God is a family. And if we make family, we win. Not a family on a spreadsheet, not a network held together by transactions, but a real spiritual household where we know our people, walk with them, carry burdens together, and protect what God is doing in their lives. That is why our structure is designed to equip and release, not contain and control. We want healthy disciple-makers who are not performing for approval, building for identity, or validating themselves for funding, but running after Jesus freely, with joy, courage, and purity.

This is also why accountability and transparency matter so deeply to us. Decentralized does not mean chaotic, hidden, or unprotected. It means sustainable structures with real relationships, real oversight, and absolute trust, the kind that can hold up under pressure. Our supporters are not outside observers of the mission, you are part of this family. You are not simply funding the underground church, you are connected to it. You are sharing in the weight, the joy, the risk, the fruit, and the worship offering being lifted to Jesus from the nations.

This culture has not come easily. The last three years have been fire, refining, pruning, and rebuilding, again and again. And we are committed to continuing to live that way. We will continue to test everything we do, and we will be willing to set fire to anything, systems, strategies, even good ideas, if they begin to drift from the identity of Jesus. We want what is built to look like Him, sound like Him, and produce what He produces.

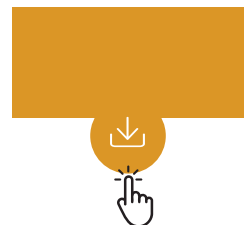

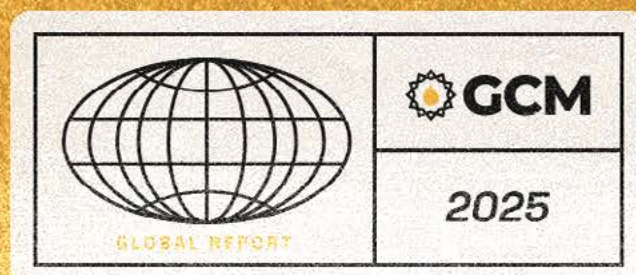
